### **Police Blotter**

Friday, August 6<sup>th</sup>, 2010:

Thursday, August 12<sup>th</sup>, 2010

- Police were dispatched to a Hope Road address for a disturbance. Police arrived on location and found that a dispute had occurred between two parties. No arrests were made.
- Police were dispatched to a Stonybrook Road address for a residential burglar alarm.
