Press Release – September 14, 2008

On Saturday, September 9, 2008 Blairstown Police responded to a Mohican Road, Blairstown Township residence for a domestic dispute. Marcelo Tise, of Mohican Road, was arrested and charged with Criminal Mischief for damaging property in excess of \$500.00. Tise was taken to Warren County Correctional Facility in lieu of \$10,000 bail.

On Friday, September 12, 2008 Brian Miller of Mount Bethel, PA was charged with two counts of Theft by Deception for issuing numerous checks from a fraudulent bank account. Miller was also charged with Forgery and Bad Checks. Miller was taken to Warren County Correctional Facility in lieu of \$20,000 bail.

On Sunday, September 14, 2008 Douglas Robb of Gayle Drive, Blairstown Township was charged with Obstruction of Justice, Resisting Arrest, and Disorderly Conduct as a result of a mental health emergency at his residence. Robb physically resisted while Officers attempted to place him under arrest.

On Thursday, September 11, 2008 Aboubakry Ly of Main Street, Blairstown Township was arrested on an outstanding warrant from North Warren Municipal Court for failure to appear for a court hearing. Ly was originally charged with Driving While Intoxicated in Blairstown Township.

On Tuesday, September 9, 2008 Blairstown Police responded to a domestic dispute at a Union Brick Road residence. During the investigation the suspect fled on foot from police. Police were later able to arrest the suspect after a physical struggle. Two Blairstown Police Officers were injured in the struggle. The suspect, Harry Waldron Sr, was arrested and charged with two counts of Aggravated Assault on a Police Officer, Resisting Arrest, and Obstruction of Justice. Waldron was also charged with Simple Assault in connection with the original domestic violence call. Waldron was taken to Warren County Correctional Facility in lieu of \$10,000 bail.
